### **New Regular pick up Poly Cart Service Guidelines**

Waste Connections Poly carts should be placed with the lid opening facing the street and the handle facing the house. Please place within 2 feet from the curb so the automated arm can pick them up.

**Carts must be placed at the curb or on the turnout of your driveway before 6:00 am on your pick up day. (Opposite side as your mailbox)**

Carts cannot be placed within 5 feet of mailboxes, fences, parked cars or other objects.

**Only your poly cart and bagged (up to 4) lawn and leaf clippings will be picked up on your regular trash pick up. No other trash cans will be picked up on your regular trash day.**

Items cannot be placed on top of the cart; extra bags for lawn and leaf clippings and bundled limbs must be placed on the ground beside the cart. Any items placed on top the cart will fall to the ground when the automated arm picks them up.

Try to get everything in the cart so the automated arm can pick it up. **Please do not overfill your cart so that the lid will close properly.**

**If you need an additional cart, carts are available and may be ordered by contacting the City of Guthrie.**

The trucks will run one side of the street at a time. If they pass your house, it may be two to three Hours before they come back to get the other side. **“They will be back.”**

If you have multiple carts, put them three to four feet apart so the automated arms can get around each of them.

Rear Load trucks will collect bulky items that do not fit in the new automated truck on your bulky waste day. **See the bulky waste flyer below for your Bulky Wednesday.**

Per City Ordinances 2999, 9-1,9-2 and 9-3, all residential and commercial trash service is required to accept and use the refuse and garbage services provided by the city and/or its private contractor.

Personally contracted services are not allowed.

## **YOUR WEDNESDAY BULKY WASTE PICK UP SERVICE**

We thank the citizens of Guthrie in advance for their help in keeping our city clean.

**Bulky Waste should be placed at the curb by 6:00 am and no more than three days before your pickup date. Up to 3 cubic yards per month. If you put out more than 3 cubic yards, you will be charged \$7.00 for every cubic yard over the limit.**

- ❖ Items should be set at least five feet from mailboxes, gas meters, cars, shrubs, or anything else that could interfere with hand loading or mechanical.
- ❖ For the same reason, items should be set at least ten feet away from utility poles, to prevent contact with overhead power lines.
- ❖ Bulky waste pick up is for household items not normally picked up with your regular poly cart residential trash pick up.
- ❖ Bulky waste must be in a size and length that will fit in the hopper of the garbage truck

### **Here's what we can pick up:**

Must be able to be lifted and handled by two persons and manageable:

Discarded household appliances, Water tanks, Discarded Furniture, Mattresses

Extra Large cardboard boxes (broken down and tied into tight bundles)

Trees, limbs and wood scrap (tied and bundled, max length of (4) feet, not more than (55) lbs)

Fencing (up to 4 panels)

Non-contracted remodeling waste that is containerized (that is, leftovers from do-it-yourself projects)

Appliances must not contain Freon, such as old refrigerators and window air conditioners, compressor must be removed or it has a sticker showing certified removal.

**We can't pick up:**

hospital/medical waste or hazardous waste of any kind  
poisons, acids and caustics, explosives  
dirt and rocks, bricks (concrete)  
sewage and liquid waste, nuclear materials  
gasoline, kerosene, oils and other fuels  
propane tanks, degreasers, lubricants, brake fluid ,antifreeze, batteries  
tires and rims, car batteries, sheet rock or roofing items  
contracted construction, reconstruction, demolition and repair waste,  
storm debris.

SOME OF THESE ITEMS CAN BE ACCEPTED AT THE CITY CONVIENINCE CENTER
