The regular meeting of the sixty-sixth City Council of Guthrie, Oklahoma was posted on Friday, April 29, 2022 before 5:00 p.m. and held Tuesday, May 3, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Vice Mayor Jim Case called the meeting to order at 7:09 p.m. and declared a quorum with 5 (five) Councilmembers in attendance.
